Holy Cross Summer Faith Fun 2020 **CRAFT**:

Blessing Wreath

Materials Needed:

- Colorful construction paper
- Glue (either craft glue, school glue, or tacky glue)
- Markers
- Paper plates
- Piece of string per child

Procedure:

- 1. First, outline each child's hand print. Cut out this outline from paper so that you have a paper hand for each child. (You can also use the provided hand outline on the next page.)
- 2. Take a sheet of paper and fold it into fourths. Lay the outline of the hand on this stack so that you can cut multiple hand outlines at a time.





- 3. Use the outlines of the children's hands to cut out 6-8 colorful hands for each child, giving a variety of colors for each child.
- 4. On the back of the paper plate, write, "My Blessings" in the middle.
- 5. Together, brainstorm the blessings in your children's lives. Talk about this and gather their responses together. (Examples: good food, family, friends, pets, talents, etc.)
- My Blessings #
- 6. Either have your children write (or you can write their words) a different blessing for each hand. Fill in each of the hands, each with a blessing.









7. Glue the colorful hands around the outside of the plate, forming a wreath.



- 8. Add the piece of string to the other side of the plate, making a loop to hang the wreath somewhere.
- 9. Talk about how we have many blessings in our lives. These wreaths can help us remember these blessings each and every day!
