GAME:
Bible Treasure Hunt



Materials Needed:

- Printed out clues
- Some sort of goodie bag for each child (this can be a simple lunch bag)
- Animal Crackers or some animal shaped snack
- Apple gummies, dried apples, or an apple treat
- Star-shaped crackers or pretzels or star erasers or pencils with stars on them
- Goldfish crackers
- A blue play item (blue bottle of bubbles, blue jump rope, blue chalk, blue frisbee, etc.)
- Materials to make homemade crosses (sticks and string)

Procedure:

1. Before playing, print and cut out the clues, then place the clues and the prizes around the house and outside to go along with the scavenger hunt.
 - a. Start with clue one, handing it to the children first.
 - b. Clue two should be placed near the stove, along with an apple treat.
 - c. Clue three should be outside on a porch in the yard with animal crackers.
 - d. Clue four should be in the dining area with
 - e. Clue five should be in the bathtub or shower with goldfish crackers.
 - f. Clue six should be on Mom's bed with the blue item.
 - g. Final prize (cross materials) is where you usually set or charge your phones.
2. Explain to the children how a scavenger hunt works. We will get clues and we will need to figure out where to go. We will get a new clue when we arrive at each.
3. Try to allow each child the chance to lead the group to a clue as you go through the clues together.
4. Place the prizes in the goodie bags as you go!
5. Have fun!
