Holy Cross Parish Family Faith Fun 2021 GAME: *Trinity Tag*

Materials Needed:

- Children, ideally more than 7
- A safe space to run around

Procedure:

- This game follows the classic game of tag, with a fun variation.
- Begin with one child being "it." This child will be trying to catch and tag other children.
- The rest of the children should be ideally in groups of 3. (If you need to make a group of 2 or 4 to make sure to include everyone, that is fine!)
- The groups stay connected, holding hands in chains and running away from the child who is "it."
- Each group has the chance to protect themselves by forming a triangle before one of the group gets tagged. If the group can quickly form a triangle, united at all three points, then no one is tagged and the "it" child stays as "it."
- If the group can't form a triangle in time, then the child who is tagged becomes the new "it."
- Play this game as long as the children are having fun with it.
- After playing a few rounds, have a debriefing conversation together:
 - Why did we form triangles to protect ourselves from being tagged? (*The triangle is a symbol of the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.*)
 - How can the Trinity keep us safe? When can we reach out to the Trinity to help us?
