

After many years and thorough study, discussion and prayerful discernment, parish leaders developed a master plan to address our current needs and best prepare our campus for years to come. As part of this plan, we will construct the new Holy Cross Community Center. Our preparation included feedback received from members of our faith and school community as part of the planning study and professional guidance from an architect and construction cost estimator.

OUR Master Plan

Goals and Costs


Estimated Project Cost: \$4.5 MILLION*

The Building Our Community - Blessing Our Future campaign leadership team has set the fundraising goal for Holy Cross Parish and School at \$1.5 million. Every dollar that we raise in support of this project means less parish savings that will need to be used. We are asking everyone to make a sacrificial gift to help us reach our Challenge Goal and beyond.

- Foundation Goal \$750,000
- Celebration Goal \$1.2 million
- Challenge Goal \$1.5 million

\$4.5 million will be raised through fundraising from our faith community, as well as requests to foundations and local businesses, and the remaining will be supplemented with parish savings.

*This estimated budget includes construction as well as soft costs such as project design, consulting, land use, permits, fixtures, furniture and equipment needs. Building plans are conceptual, and final project design and total costs may vary from the estimates available as of lanuary 2023.



PROJECT PLANS

Imagine a place with larger gathering space for after-Mass fellowship, school activities, and additional room for faith formation and ministry activities.

"For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." (Matthew 18:20)

This project is more than a building. It is an opportunity. The opportunity to welcome everyone inside with no barriers to entry. The opportunity to reinstate beloved gatherings such as senior luncheons and community potlucks. The opportunity to host celebrations and funeral tributes. The opportunity to expand our thriving school. The opportunity to include more people in Bible studies, prayer groups and youth group activities.

he Holy Cross Community Center will be constructed adjacent to the church and directly across from the school, becoming central to the lives of our parishioners, school children and the larger community. This location will not require the acquisition of additional land. Construction is estimated to begin in 2024.

Our new parish center will allow Holy Cross to provide our parish and school with the infrastructure needed to welcome, serve, build, form and continue our mission as Catholics. Built across one fully accessible level with approximately 5,500 square feet in total size, the community center will feature:



- Large gathering space to host up to 230 seated at tables. This venue will be available to host after-Mass fellowship, ministry formation, wedding and funeral receptions, the school's Christmas program and graduation, and other parish and school gatherings.
- Serving kitchen and storage pantry.
- Multipurpose meeting space.
- New St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry.
- Designated storage area.
- Outside patio and garden area, ideal for hosting hospitality events and an aesthetic enhancement to our campus.
- Accessible restrooms.
- Built-in technology and sound system for events and presentations.

God, in His goodness, has transformed what started in 1902 as a gathering of the faithful in a chapel at the then Columbia University to today what is a spirit-filled church and school of more than 700 families. Over the years, Holy Cross has evolved and grown out of one church building and started a school. We welcomed fellow North Portland Catholics during the merge of multiple parishes to become the vibrant and diverse faith community we are today. Through all these evolutions we have never had a standalone parish community center to welcome and serve all our faith community's needs.

When asked what they love most about Holy Cross, our people overwhelmingly said the strong community and friendships. That is why enhanced opportunities to gather as a community in large and small groups are at the heart of our vision for the Building Our Community - Blessing Our Future Capital Campaign. Our goal is about more than constructing a new facility; it is about fostering community while building up the faith.

WAYS TO GIVE

There are many avenues of giving to allow you to meet your needs and support Holy Cross Catholic Community in a meaningful way. Pledges are commitments made in good faith but are not legally binding. You may want to consider stretching your pledge over a three-year period to maximize the total amount of your support. This commitment can be fulfilled through monthly, quarterly, semiannual or annual installments. Your gift is intended solely to support the Building Our Community - Blessing Our Future Capital Campaign and can only be used for its goals.

We encourage all donors to consider a 10-30 percent initial payment to begin your commitment to help us address our immediate needs and ensure we can begin construction as soon as possible.

ONLINE GIVING

You may set up an automatic withdrawal or payment from a bank account, credit card or debit card to make initial gifts and recurring payments. Please visit us at holycrosspdx.org to complete this process.

GIFTS OF SECURITIES

Charitable gifts of stocks, bonds or mutual funds that have appreciated in value can have an immediate impact on our campaign and avoid capital gains tax. Please contact the parish office for more information.

DIRECT CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION FROM A RETIREMENT ACCOUNT

Benefactors can make charitable gifts using funds from tax-deferred individual retirement accounts (IRAs). Donors may use this strategy to satisfy part, or all, of their required minimum distribution (up to \$100,000 max allowable amount per year) and lower overall tax liability to benefit Holy Cross.

CORPORATE MATCHING GIFTS

A matching gift program provided through your employer may allow you to increase the value of your gift. Many companies match charitable gifts made by their employees, retirees or board members.

PLANNED GIFTS

Planned gifts provide opportunities to make a meaningful commitment to the campaign now as part of your financial and estate planning. Such gifts can allow donors to accomplish charitable giving goals and take advantage of tax laws. Opportunities may include bequests from a will or a living trust, life insurance, real estate, designating Holy Cross as beneficiary (e.g., brokerage transfer on death agreement, retirement account beneficiaries, life insurance beneficiaries), or various trust options (e.g., charitable lead trust).
